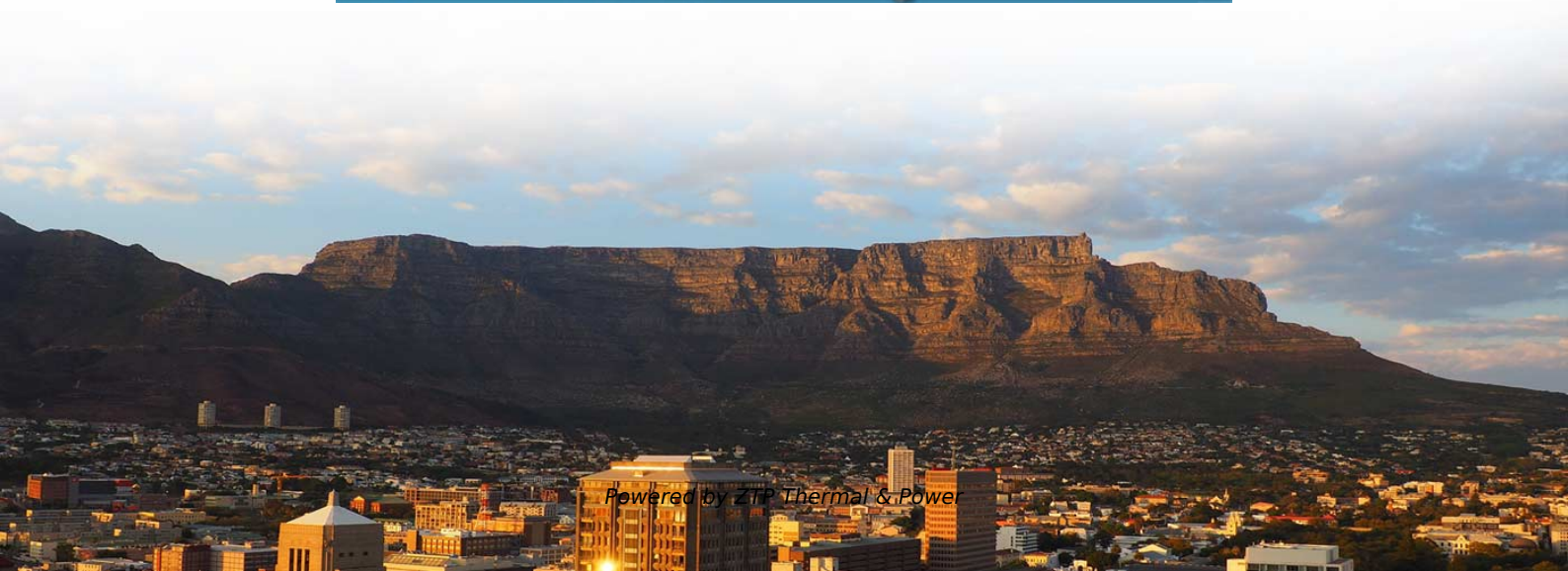


Can fiber optic cables be suspended in the air





Overview

Aerial optical cable is suspended in the air from poles and/or support structures. Most often it is supported between poles by being lashed to a wire rope messenger strand with a small gauge wire. Deploying fiber above ground on poles or towers removes the need for underground digging and is particularly useful when the ground is uneven, rocky or both. Unlike buried cable, they excel in rural or suburban areas where trenching is impractical. Where reels are supplied with protective material fitted over the cable, the protection should remain in place until the cable will be installed.

Aerial outdoor cables are suspended from poles or pylons or mounted on buildings. Some are self-supporting, requiring no separate messenger wire between poles to support the cable's weight.



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Sometimes lightweight fiber cable may be lashed to previously installed cables such as older copper phone cables or CATV hardline coax, but proper permissions must be obtained.

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Optical Fiber Cable Installation Guideline

The procedure for stripping fiber optic cables is very similar to electronic cables. However, care should be taken not to cut into the layer of aramid directly beneath the jacket.

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Air-blown fiber should not be confused with "Blown Cable" where special cable is floated on air and pushed into a duct. See this FOA Guide section for Blowing
