Overview

Although the maximum distance of fiber optic cable is impacted by both attenuation and dispersion, for most applications, the maximum distance of any kind of fiber optic cable is approximately 62. As data demands continue to increase exponentially, the choices you make today regarding your network infrastructure will have a direct impact. Many factors decide the fiber cable distance, but the key factors include the below six aspects. Minimize mechanical pressure on the outer sheath at crossing points: (armoured) cables crossing each other generate points of high pressure, so it is important when laying in figure 8 loops it is done in a correct way.
