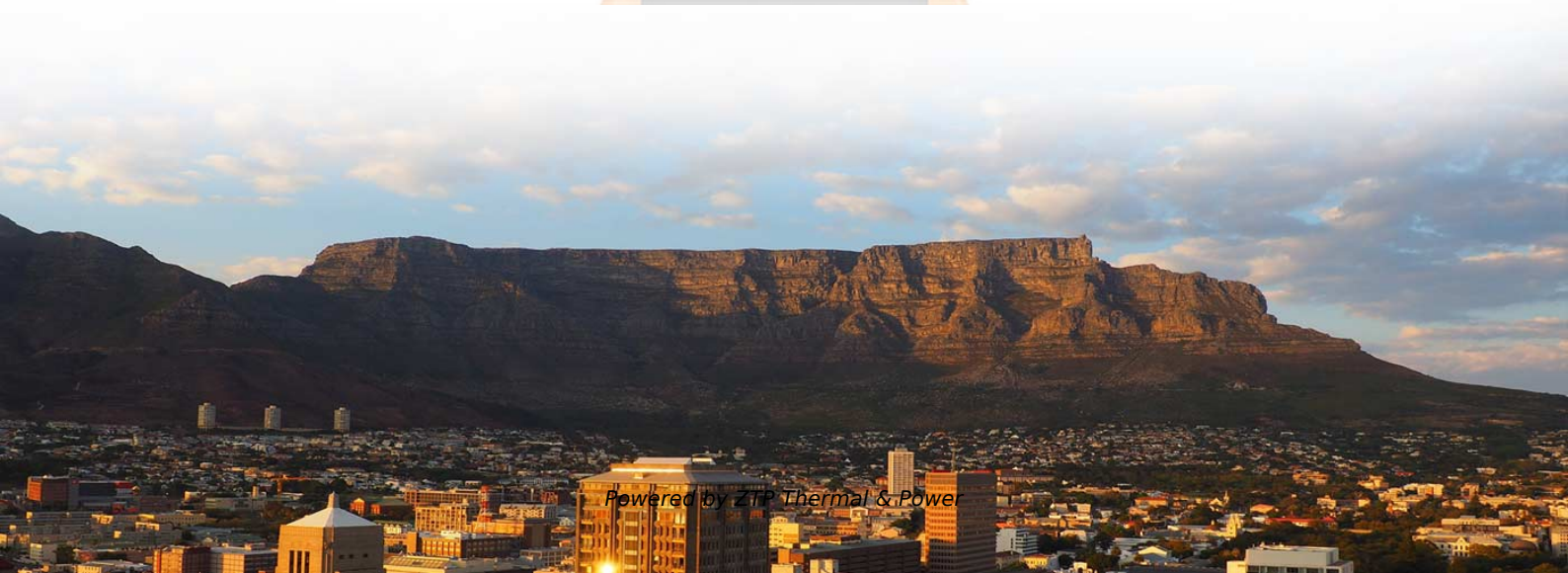


Fiber optic lc interface is small square
