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VLAN on Firewall and VLAN on Switch

Vlans on firewalls (e.g. Sophos) and switches are conceptually the same, that is, they are logical entities tied to physical ports, for the purpose of network separation.

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Should I build a VLAN between firewall and core layer 3

This firewall hangs directly off of our core, layer 3 routing switch. (See Current Configuration image below.) My question is, should I build a layer 3 Vlan

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You can either use a separate connection for each VLAN between the central switch and the firewall - not really efficient -, or you can use a VLAN trunk to connect multiple, tagged VLANs
