

How to strip optical fiber cables during fiber splicing





Overview

Begin by carefully removing the cable's outer jacket, strength members, and buffer tubes using a fiber optic stripper until the bare fiber is exposed. It is impossible to work in fiber optics without having a good working knowledge about cables and skills in pulling, placing and preparing cables for termination and splicing. What happens if you damage the fiber during this production step?

A tiny scratch or nick in the optical fiber is like a time bomb. This fiber optic splicing technique involves the precise alignment of two fiber optic cables, held in place by a self-contained assembly rather than a permanent bond.
