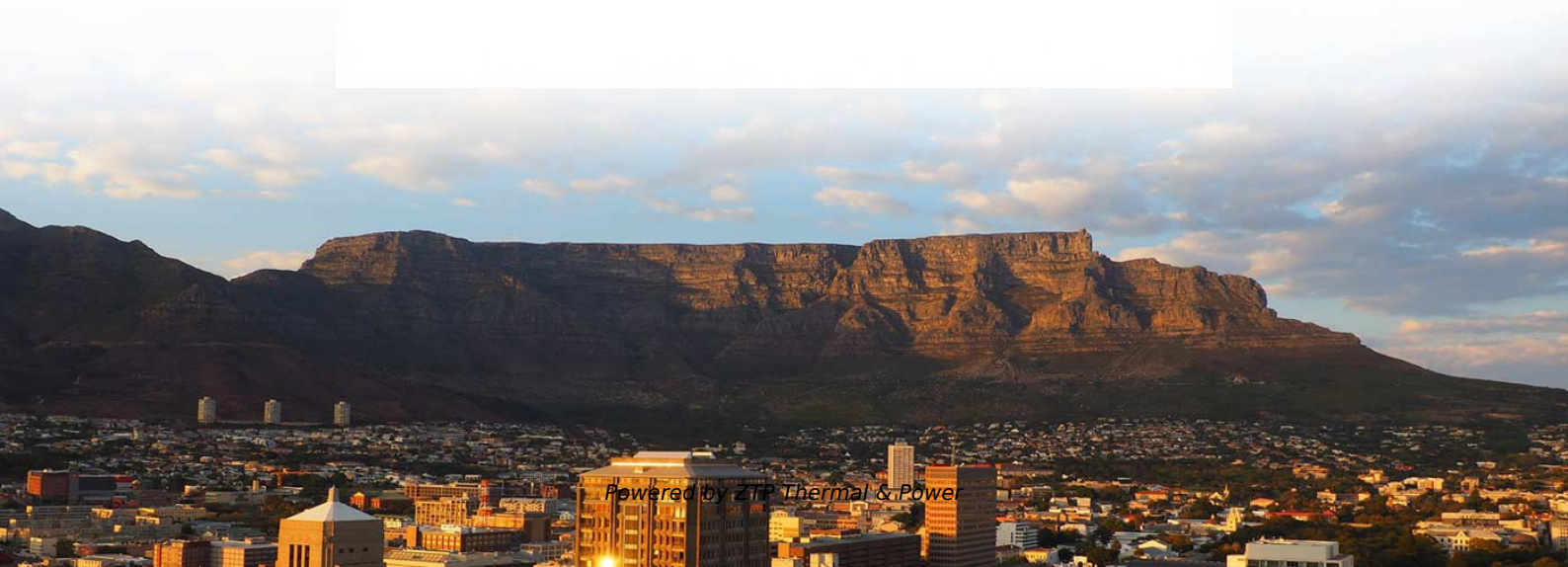


# Indoor circuit breaker trips even though the distribution box doesn't trip
