Overview

SONGWE: THE Tanzanian government, through the Universal Communications Service Access Fund (UCSAF), is set to construct a new phase of 280 communication towers across the country, focusing on border zones, wildlife reserves, and key railway corridors, including the Standard. The project marks a significant expansion of Tanzania's national connectivity infrastructure, aimed at improving access to reliable and high-quality telecommunications services across the country, particularly in underserved and remote areas. Tanzania has completed 57% of its planned 758 telecom towers and upgraded 304 sites to 3G/4G networks.
