Overview

26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. The ground busbar terminal in the service equipment (main panel) should be securely connected to the grounding rod using a properly sized equipment grounding conductor, as specified in NEC Table 250.
