

What is the inner layer of a fiber optic patch cord





Overview

A fiber-optic patch cord is constructed from a core with a high, surrounded by a coating with a low refractive index, that is strengthened by and surrounded by a protective jacket. The protective aramid yarns and outer jacket minimize physical damage to the core and coating. The coating's lower refractive index causes light to be reflected back toward the core, minimizing signal loss. The protective aramid yarns and outer jacket minimize physical damage to the core and coating.
