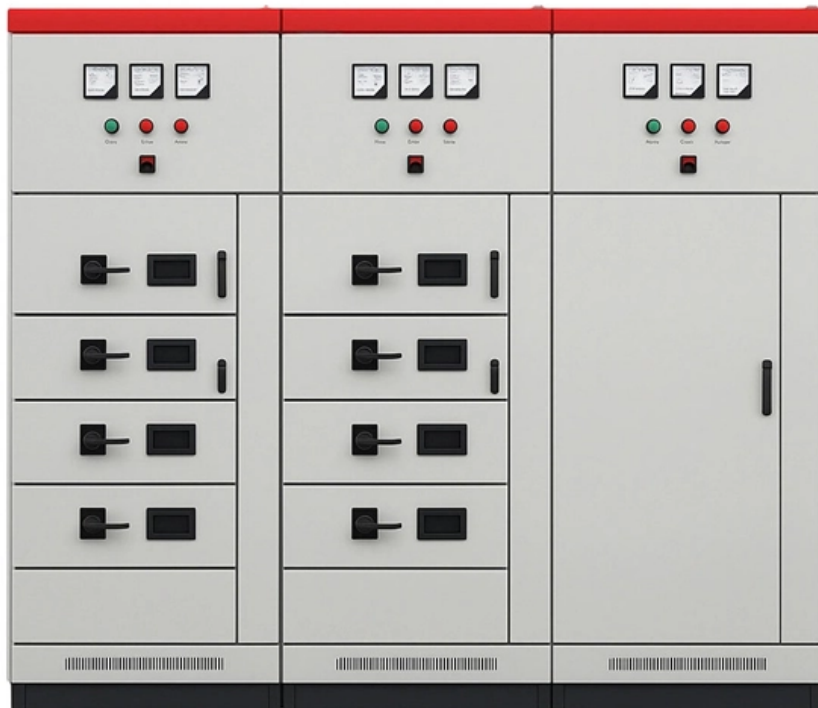


What optical modules are used for switch stacking
