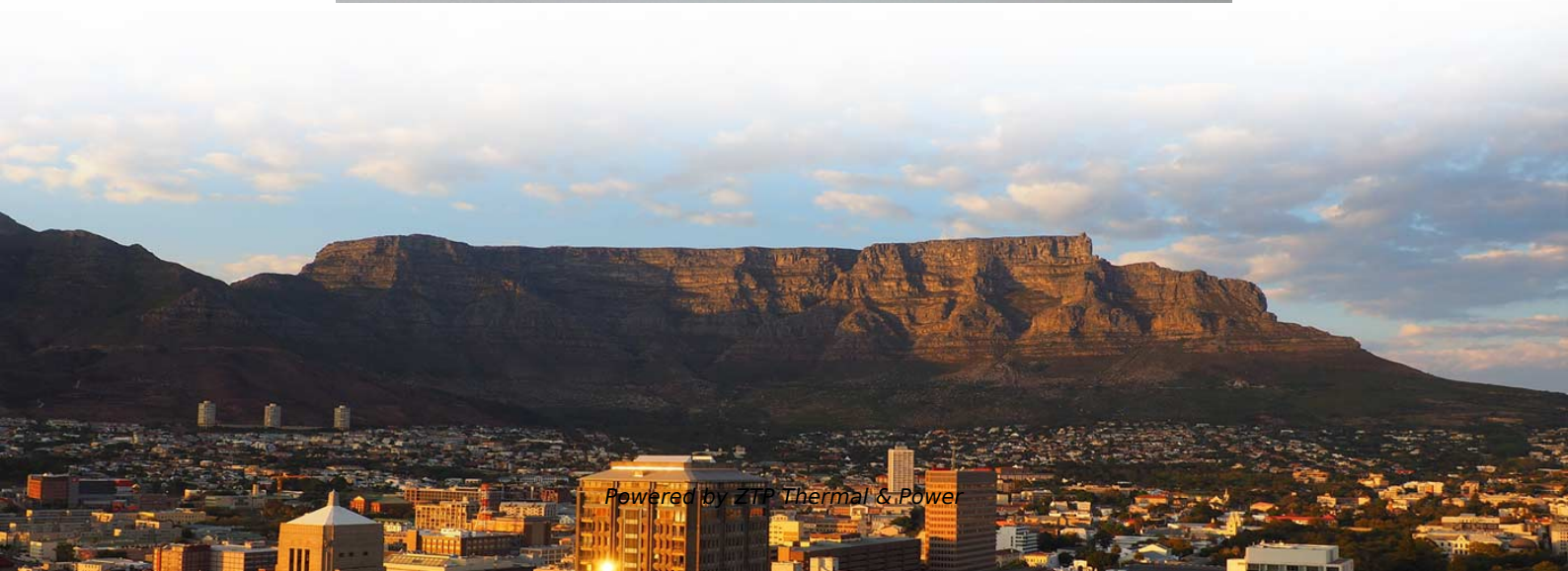


Why is a pigtail interface necessary





Overview

Pigtails isolate devices from the main circuit, allowing individual components like outlets or switches to be serviced without disrupting downstream connections. This method also reduces strain on terminal screws and ensures consistent power distribution. It ensures a secure connection by combining wires with a wire connector, like a twist-on connector or a wire nut, and then linking them to the intended terminal or fixture. A pigtail connector is a short, pre-terminated length of cable with one end connected to a connector and the other end left open or spliced into another assembly.
